when created Where the resolution of a raster image is determined

when outputed Where the resolution of a vector image is determined

Fact: 300 dpi and 300 lpi are not the same

133 to 150 line screen is commonly used for magazines

150 300 dpi image = 2 inches wide, increased to 4 inches wide the resolution after resizing the image

the Freeform Pen tool in Magnetic mode hold down the mouse button to lay down

.psd identifies a native Photoshop file

“Bleeding” ink on one side of paper showing through on the other side

embedded link to the placed file Smart Object

Option/Alt changes the Cancel button to a Reset button

result of dragging an image thumbnail image is added to the active file as a Smart Object layer

from the Mini Bridge panel

result of dragging regular layer image is added to the active file as a regular layer

from 1 document window to another

Edit>Transform>Flip Horizontal affects only the active layer in a file

Quick Selection tool used to select large, irregular areas of solid color

Marching “ants” identifies the edges of a selected area

Frequency Lasso tool in Magnetic mode: defines the number of points

Wrap text Transform mode: option is NOT available in the Option

Feather used to soften the edge of the selection

Fact: Unmasked areas are copied to a separate layer when using layer mask

It is not possible to preserve deleted pixels in Photoshop CS6. correct procedure to make sure the full image outside the cropped area is still available
